GOOD STANDING POLICY

The Good Standing Policy supports and works in conjunction with the whole school Behaviour Management Policy. As such, the Policy aims to provide all students with the support needed to learn and maintain positive behaviours.

'Good Standing' is a status all students are granted at the beginning of each term. It is expected that students will maintain this status throughout their schooling at South Halls Head.

Students with Good Standing are eligible to participate in extra-curricular school events, including but not limited to: excursions, incursions, Graduation, interschool sports carnivals, discos or represent the school in other activities.

To maintain 'Good Standing'

Students must –

- Comply with school rules –
 - Follow staff instructions immediately
 - Keep hands and feet to yourself
 - Show respect for others and the environment

A student's Good Standing will be withdrawn, following consultation with the teacher, administration and parent/carer, for any of the following:

- Four detentions in one term (Step 5 in the Behaviour Management Policy)
- One withdrawal
- One suspension

The decision to withdraw Good Standing rests with the principal.

Regaining Good Standing

A re-entry meeting will be held with the student, parent/carer, teacher and administration on their return to class/school from a suspension, withdrawal or repeated detentions.

A Good Standing Contract will be developed setting behavioural and academic targets for the student.

A 'Star' target will be established. 'Stars' are awarded by teachers based on how well the student is achieving these targets during each lesson.

When the agreed 'Star' target is reached, the student's Good Standing Status will be reinstated.
